Certainly one of the top spots for a weekend away or a longer stay, this historic city is one of the architectural gems of the Mediterranean. Dominated by the vast Cathedral, narrow streets lead to peaceful squares, hundreds of tiny shops in the old town lanes contrast with nearby international designer boutiques on the main streets. Around every corner, fascinating plazas and ancient buildings are waiting to be explored.



Hotel Dalt Murada Turismo d'Interior

In historic Almudaina, the most famous medieval street in the city, stands a 15th century house, once the home of an important Nobleman in the service of King Alfonso V. This ancient property has been transformed into a small hotel. It is centrally located just a few paces from the Cathedral and close to a maze of narrow lanes lined with absorbing small shops.

The interior has been carefully restored and the furnishings include antiques and paintings which have been in the owner's family for many generations. There are three double bedrooms plus five suites which are equipped with a jacuzzi bath. All rooms have air-conditioning, satellite television and minibar. Each room is named after famous painters.

Lounge. Breakfast is usually served outside on a secluded garden patio. Naturally, there are numerous restaurants within easy walking distance and the hotel will make suitable suggestions and recommendations.

8 rooms. Lift. Transfer time 20 mins. Open all year.

Hotel Convent de la Missió ✧ ✧ ✧ ✧

This former 17th century convent has been transformed into a stylish and most sophisticated hotel. It is secreted away just moments from the main shopping thoroughfares and art galleries.

Decidedly ethereal, the air-conditioned minimalist interior is a fusion of the past with the present. All the period features have been retained and the starkly white limestone walls are accentuated by designer lighting. The vast art gallery is an important feature of the hotel with an ever changing display of modernist art and sculptures.

The glamorous bedrooms are superbly appointed with king size or four-poster beds, a discreetly hidden satellite television, minibar, Internet connection and a contemporary chrome and glass bathroom replete with luxury toiletries.

There is an ultra modern lounge, cocktail bar. The prestigious and beautiful *Refectori* restaurant is one of the best on the island and reservations are essential. Whirlpool and sauna deep down in the old crypt and an oriental style roof terrace.
